

### Early Years & Junior School Items Required for Scholastic Year 2019 - 2020

#### Year 1 & Year 2 (everything is to be labelled).

- A school bag large enough to hold the folder, pencil case (not tins and instead display pencil cases are recommended) and a lunch bag
- Lunch bag containing **2 lunch boxes** (one for small break, one for big break) and a bottle of water
- Clipped name badge holding the child's name, class, contact number and van colour (if using transport)
- An A4 'box-file' (see an example below)
- 2 Whiteboard markers (black/blue & green/red)
- Writing tools: 3 Hb2 pencils (only HB2), a sharpener with container, ruler and an eraser
- 2 Large Box of Tissues and 2 large packets of wipes
- 1 Large and 1 small Glue Stick
- An extra pair of socks and underpants (to be kept in the school bag at all times)
- Painting aprons (labelled)
- Safety metal scissors (rounded at the top)
- A5 scrapbook (\*see photo below)
- <u>Year 1 only</u>: A full packet of thick colouring pencils and their sharpener, a set of bright coloured glitter glue (ex. Gold/silver/blue/red ex) and 1 Chubby triangular pencil (see picture below)





Year 2 only: Plastic copybook covers - 1 of each of the following colours: red, orange, blue, white, yellow, and pink. Please stick a label to each copybook cover with the name and surname filled in, and 3 plastic A4 button envelope folders to store completed worksheets and reading books – English and Maltese (\*see an example below).

#### <u>Year 4</u>

- 6 blue plastic covers for Maltese copybooks
- 6 green plastic covers for English copybooks
- 5 red plastic covers for Mathematics copybooks
- 3 project books (History, Geography and Science) student's notebook white pages lined/blank. The books are to be covered in brown paper and subject appropriate pictures.
- 3 transparent plastic covers for these project books
- 2 display files (40 sheets) preferably one green and one blue
- 2 plastic files (use last year's)
- Small white board, eraser, white board markers (black/blue & green/red), a pair of children's scissors, a twelve inch <u>flat</u> ruler, a yellow highlighter, a large stick of glue,



3HB pencils, sharpener, colouring pencils. These are for classroom use, separate from Art supplies.

- A4 file paper
- 1 USB or pen-drive for ICT
- An A4 'box-file' (for homework)
- Large Box of Tissues and 1 packet of wipes

#### English:

- Blue display book
- 4 blue copybook covers

#### Maths:

- Red display book
- 4 Red copybook covers

#### Maltese:

- Green display book
- 4 Green copybook covers

#### History:

- Pink display book
- 1 pink copybook cover

#### Science:

- Orange display book
- 1 orange copybook cover

#### **Geography:**

- Purple display book
- 1 purple copybook cover



#### **Religion**

- Yellow display book
- 1 yellow copybook cover

#### ICT

- Black display book
- 1 Black copybook cover
- 1 USB pen drive
- Ruler (large), pencil HB/2HB, blue pen, eraser, sharpener, highlighter any colour, glue stick, pack of post-it/sticky notes
- 1 set of colouring pencils
- 1 set of colouring pens/markers
- White board markers, black, red, blue, green
- 1 small white board and white board eraser/cleaner
- 1 pair of classroom scissors
- 1 pkt of tissues and 1 pkt of alcohol wipes

#### <u>Year 6</u>

- English Language 1 blue plastic cover (A4 Size)
- English Language 4 A4 project books without blank pages for drawing.
- 1 reading book of the boy's choice, the book will stay in class for the full year and will be used as part of a 'Love Reading' library scheme. It will go home with the boys at the end of the year.
- Science 2 A4 Project books with 1 A4 clear plastic cover.
- Maltese 1 display folder and 5 red plastic covers
- Mathematics –1 purple plastic cover (A5 size)
- Italian 1 exercise book, 1 green plastic cover and 1 A4 green plastic folder
- French 1 exercise book, 1 blue plastic cover and 1 A4 blue plastic folder
- Religion 1 A4 project book (the one with alternate lined and blank pages) covered in paper with a religious theme then in plastic and 1 yellow A4 plastic file
- 1 clear 2 ring folder with A4 lined paper to insert inside for note taking.
- ICT 1 USB pen drive and 1 A4 ring file (2 rings clear colour)



- Family Links PSHE 1 A4 Project Book with 1 clear plastic cover, to be covered in paper or pictures which the boys like, for example pictures of the boys' family, favourite sport etc.
- 2 plastic containers jam jar style with lids.
- 1 packet of plain colour pompoms and 1 packet of glitter pompoms.



#### Year 6 - General:

- Ruler (large and clear 30cm not a flexible bendy ruler).
- Pencil HB/2HB.
- Blue pen not a Friction pen or erasable ink.
- Eraser.
- Sharpener with sharpening pot.
- Highlighter (any colour).
- Glue stick (large).
- Pack of post-it/sticky notes
- 1 protractor
- 1 hole puncher with tray, for making 2 holes
- 1 set of colouring pencils
- 1 set of colouring pens/markers
- White board markers, black, red, blue, green
- 1 small white board and white board eraser/cleaner
- 1 pair of classroom scissors
- pkt of tissues and 1 pkt of alcohol wipes
- 2 pkts of modeling clay (grey colour)
- Clear wallets to put inside the A4 ring binder for loose sheets
